Affiliated with a University or Cyber NYC partner organization


One of the team members must be a faculty, student, fellow, staff member, or alumni at an accredited NYC University or Fullstack



Venture Stage

What is the I2F Accelerator? Validation Phase

- 12 week bootcamp with dual focused curriculum
- Comprehensive support system to build your company
- Access to an engaged network of top-tier investors, mentors and key players in cyber security
- Non-dilutive funding

Incubation Phase

- Up to 5 months of incubation, includes option to accept equity investment
- Only a subset of validation graduates will be accepted into incubation phase

Technology. What is your technology and what have you done to develop it

Problem. What problem are you solving and what markets are you targeting

Commitment. Can your team commit to the weekly bootcamp sessions and outside work
